## STORY WALKS:

StoryWalks encourage families to enjoy reading and the outdoors by posting a children's book – a page at a time – at intervals along a path.

Area Story Walks:

- Fond du Lac: There are two in Fond du Lac. One is in Hamilton Park, which is
  just a couple blocks west of the Fond du Lac Public Library. The other is in
  Lakeside Park East, near the intersection of Harbor View Drive and Winnebago
  Drive.
- Oshkosh: Located at 3001 S. Washburn St., Oshkosh.
- Montello: Located on Sunset Drive, Montello, suggested to park at Montello
   Public Library 128 Lake Court (behind the fire station) and walk along Buffalo
   Lake shoreline to Krakow Memorial Park. There are 15 kiosks along the way to
   read the story. Rendezvous Paddle & Sports restaurant/bar is at the end of the
   story trail if you need refreshments afterwards:)
- **Hancock:** Located at Whistler Mounds Park, N4159 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Hancock. It features Native American themed books, open May thru October, story changes on the 15<sup>th</sup> each month. The walk is less then a half mile around the mounds. There is a shelter that can be used for a picnic lunch.
- **Pine River:** Located at Willow Creek County Park, W5804 County Road W, Wild Rose, right next to the Nordic Mountain Ski Hill entrance.
